

Family head	The history of the Sasanami Family
Kyuemon the 1 st	He came to Hokkaido from Ishikawa prefecture in the middle of the Edo Period. 1716-1732
Kyuemon the 2 nd	He died in 1770.
Kyuemon the 3 rd	He died in 1801.
Kyuemon the 4 th	He was born in 1803 and died in 1826.
Kyuemon the 5 th	He was born in 1761.
	It is said that he built this house in the early 1800s.
	In 1857, the foundation of house was changed and the roof was changed in 1858.
	He died in 1838.
Kyuemon the 6 th	He was born in 1787 and died in 1843.
Kyuemon the 7 th	He was born in 1813 and died in 1856.
Kyuemon the 8 th	He was born in 1835.
	He served as a headman of Kaminokuni from 1861 to 1866.
	He introduced a fish set net (fish trap) in 1866 and he began to sell fancy goods and managed the marine products industry.
	The Sasanami Family was given the rank of samurai (=being permitted to adopt a surname and wear a pair of swords) in 1867.
	The group of the lord of the Matsumae Clan visited during their trip in 1872.
	He served as a headman of Kaminokuni in 1871.
	He contributed to paddy cultivation and established schools in 1878.
	He died in 1883.
Kyuemon the 9 th	He was born in 1874 and died in 1930.
Kyuemon the 10 th	He was born in 1875 and died in 1920.
	He succeeded the family head and from the result of a conference, the Sasanami Family decided to quit the fishing industry due to poor catch of herring.
	He went to Karahuto as a hired fisherman and died in 1920 there.
Kyuei The 11 th generation	He was born in 1903.
	He was a teacher and succeeded the family head in 1931, but didn't succeed 'Kyuemon'.
	He died in 1989.
