

# Tomb pile and position of the tomb

## ~Way of making No.3 tomb~



No.3 tomb coffin south side  
The thickness of the plate was about 2 cm.



Inside of No.3 coffin ~decorations and nails~  
The hole of the tomb is 1.35x1 m, depth is 50 cm. There were eight coins and a piece of lacquerware. Head faced to the north.



This was the tomb hole on the left side (dark area). The den might be a hole for a wooden grave post.

There are grooves to pile up the tomb after the coffin is buried.

The crescent-shaped deposition is volcanic ash from when the volcano erupted in 1640.

At first, the pile up of the tomb was higher than it is now, and the left side was the highest point.
